This program focuses on social and emotional learning by teaching students about random acts of kindness and emotional intelligence. Students learn how to develop habits that will promote positive self-esteem and creative problem solving. The sessions integrate mental wellness principles through storytelling and interactive activities.

Flip, Flop, and Flo are bunny rabbit sisters who created a club to teach others the importance of happiness and how to turn a frown upside down. They teach their friends the Happy Habits Dance to put them in a happy mood anytime.

Tank the Turtle wanted to win the race, but he couldn't keep up with the others. His friends cheered him on and taught him that doing his best and not quitting was more important than winning.

Franklin the Bear doesn't understand what compliments are. Flip, Flop, and Flo explain how easy it is to brighten someone's day by saying something nice.
